OOOW!



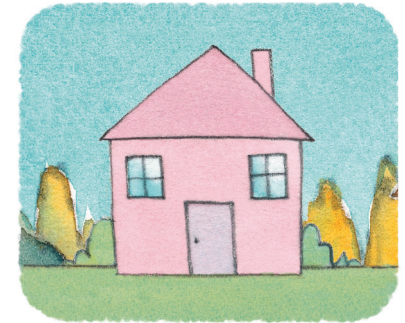
and howl like a wolf
